General Requests

Parking

This seems to be a standing item on most newsletters. We still regularly receive complaints and concerns from neighbours about parents blocking driveways at morning drop off and afternoon pick up. We do appreciate that parking is a challenge around the school but can we please ask that families are considerate of those who live close to the school and ask that you do not block or park in driveways, even for a short period of time.

Illness

We still have a high number of pupils who have winter colds, flu or sickness. Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell. If they have been sick please keep them at home for 48 hours.
